All teachers have the right to teach.

If teachers have the right to teach, then they have the responsibility to do so in an active, caring and creative way and the right to full support from administration, parents and students so that nothing will diminish their effectiveness as teachers.

Everyone has the right to feel good about who they are.

If everyone has the right to feel good about themselves, then they have the responsibility to value and respect all others in the school.

Everyone has the right to feel safe.

If everyone has the right to feel safe, then they have the responsibility to ensure that their actions do not endanger or threaten others.

This is posted in each classroom and represents the four pillars on which our school community is built. If everyone respects these rights and accepts these responsibilities a positive school environment is ensured.
